Smoked tobacco		Beedis	Sun dried and flaked tobacco wrapped in dried tendu leaves	
		Chillum	A clay pipe used for smoking tobacco	
		Hookah	Device used for vaporising and smoking flavoured tobacco. The vapour or smoke is passed through water before inhalation	
		Cigarettes	A roll of cured and finely cut tobacco leaves and reconstituted tobacco rolled into a paper cylinder	
		Cigars	Tightly rolled bundles of dried and fermented tobacco	
		Chutta	Rolled tobacco leaves used like cigars	
		Reverse chutta smoking or 'addapoga'	Smoking practice keeping the lighted end of the chutta in the mouth and inhaling it	
Smokeless Tobacco	Oral form	Paan with tobacco	Paan consists of four main ingredients betel leaf, areca nut (supari), slaked lime (chuna) and catechu, often consumed with tobacco	
		Khaini	Crushed dried tobacco leaves mixed with slaked lime and chewed as a quid	
		Gutkha	Preparation of crushed betel nut, tobacco, and sweet or savory flavorings, sold in small packets	

		Paan masala	A commercial preparation of areca nut, slaked lime, catechu and condiments with or without powdered tobacco	
		Gudaku, Mishri	Paste of tobacco and sugar molasses applied on gums Mishri – roasted tobacco powder applied as tooth powder	
		Mawa	Combination of areca nut pieces, scented tobacco and slaked lime mixed on the spot and chewed	
	Nasal Form	Dry snuff	A small quantity of very fine tobacco powder mixed with aromatic substances inhaled through nose
